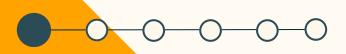


SERENA,

What are the most important linguistic and technical skills?

Soft skills like analytical thinking, adaptability, teamwork, and problem-solving are also vital in optimizing Al outputs.

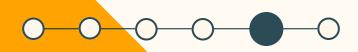




SERENA, What do you like most about your job?
